Trip to Egypt.





Monday Oct 11th, 2021:

Arrival: Arrive at Cairo Airport. Our meet-and-assist service will take you from just outside your gate through the passport control area and help you through luggage claim and customs. Then they will accompany you to your hotel **the Longchamps Boutique Hotel.**

Tuesday Oct 12th, 2021:

Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel.

Egyptian Museum: Visit to the Egyptian Museum, your Egyptologist- will escort you on a tour of 7,000 years of Egyptian history which includes the world-famous golden treasures from **King Tutankhamen's tomb.**



Lunch: Lunch in local authentic restaurant.

Ibn Tuloun Mosque: Visit the Mosque that was constructed on a small hill called Gebel Yashkur, "The Hill of Thanksgiving." One local legend says that it is here that **Noah's Ark** came to rest after the **Deluge**, rather than at **Mount Ararat**. The grand congregational mosque was intended to be the focal point of Ibn Tulun's capital, **al-Qata'i**, which served as the center of administration for the **Tulunid** dynasty.



Old Islamic Cairo: A city that is over 1000 years old. Then walk in El Muizz Street, which has the greatest concentration of medieval architectural treasures in the Islamic world. Explore the winding alleyways of the famous Khan El Khalili market, the major souk of Cairo.



Khan El Khalili Bazar: Proceed to the fascinating Khan El-Khalili Bazaar – reputed to be the largest bazaar in the Middle East. Originally founded as a watering stop for caravanserai in the 14th century.

Hotel: Transfer back to your hotel & rest.

Wednesday Oct 13th, 2021:

Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel.

Dahshour Pyramids: Meet your Egyptologist guides & drive to one of the most important Pyramids in Egypt however still an out of the beaten track visit to many of the visitors several pyramids can be found here, including the "**Bent Pyramid**". As one of the most unusual pyramids in Egypt, and also one of the best preserved as much of its casing remains, it has attracted considerable attention over the centuries.



Lunch: Lunch will be at authentic local restaurant.



Sakkara Pyramid: Visit the first limestone structure ever built. Explore its 4350 years old colored tombs. Get the chance to go inside a pyramid and see the ancient Hieroglyphics that have been engraved on its walls for thousands of years. Then proceed to visit the off-beaten track tombs of **Mhu, The brothers & the butchers.**

Thursday Oct 14th, 2021:

Giza Pyramids: Proceed to the Pyramids of Giza. The only present-day survivors of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, they are among the world's greatest tourist attractions and never lose their ability to inspire and overwhelm visitors.

Camel Ride: No trip to Egypt would be complete without a ride on a "ship of the desert", and so you will have an opportunity to mount your individual camel for an Unforgettable ride across the sands of Giza from a distance.



Sphinx: Visit to the mysterious Sphinx, an ancient figure shrouded in legend and mystery. Your Egyptologist will enthrall you with the tales told of this fascinating figure.

Friday Oct 15th, 2021:

Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel.

The Monastery of Saint Simon: Known as the **Cave Church**, is located in the Mokattam mountain in southeastern Cairo, Egypt, in an area that is known as 'garbage city' because of the large population of garbage collectors or Zabbaleen that live there. The Zabbaleen are descendants of farmers who started migrating from Upper Egypt to Cairo in the 1940s. Fleeing poor harvests and poverty they came to the city looking for work and set-up makeshift settlements around the city. Initially, they stuck to their tradition of raising pigs, goats, chickens and other animals, but eventually found collecting and sorting of waste produced by the city residents more profitable.



Coptic Cairo: Visit the remains of the old Fortress of Babylon, built at the time of the Romans in Egypt to protect the country from invading enemies. The walls of the fortress enclose the Church of St. Sergius, which is built on a crypt considered to be one of the resting places of the Holy Family during their flight to Egypt 2000 years ago.



Synagogue of Ben Ezra: Visit the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, from the time of the once thriving Jewish community in Egypt under the leadership of Rabbi Ben Ezra. Inside were discovered the so-called "Geniza Documents", which showed an unparalleled source of information about life of the Jews in Egypt's past.




Food Tour: Lunch will be a great experience by visiting 2 or 3 restaurants of local Egyptian popular food. Then a place for dessert or Ice Cream.

Hotel: Transfer back to your hotel & overnight.

Saturday Oct 16th, 2021:

Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel & checkout.



Alexandria: Drive for about 3:30 hours to Alexandria.

Catacombs: The Catacombs are the largest known Roman burial site in Egypt, consisting of three tiers of tombs and chambers cut into the rock to a depth of about 35 meters. Constructed in the 2nd century AD, probably as a family crypt, they were later expanded to hold more than 300 individual tombs. There is even a banquet hall where grieving relatives paid their last respects with a funeral feast.



Pompey's Pillar: This massive 25-metre-high pink granite column, which the Crusaders mistakenly credited to Pompey, rises out of the remains of the famed Serapeum, an acropolis including a temple dedicated to the Goddess Isis, and Cleopatra's library.



Roman Amphitheater: This is the only Roman amphitheater in Egypt, discovered quite recently, when the foundations for a new apartment building were being dug. The terraces, arranged in a semicircle around the arena, are extremely well-preserved.

Lunch: Lunch will be at local authentic restaurant.

Hotel: Transfer to your **Plaza Alexandria Hotel**, check in & overnight.

Alexandria by Night: At evening Explore the city of Alexandria & walk the cornice street.



Sunday Oct 17th, 2021:

Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel & checkout.

Alexandria Library: Visit the wonderful library is one of the most famous one's around the world and its reviving the famous ancient library of Alexandria.

Lunch: Lunch on the way to Cairo.

Transfer: Transfer back to Cairo and check in at **Le Meridien airport hotel**



Monday Oct 18th, 2021:

Arrival: Arrival in Luxor & start visiting:

Karnak Temple: Visit the **temple of Karnak**, the largest religious complex that was ever built for a god. The temple is dedicated to the god Amon Ra, the chief creator god in Ancient Egypt. Explore **Khonso Temple & the Opet festival chapel** which is one of the off beaten track sites.

Transfer: Transfer to your **Jaz Cruise Line**.

Lunch: Lunch onboard your cruise.

PM Luxor Temple: At sunset visit the **Luxor temple** that was predominantly built by Pharaoh Ramses the second.

Dinner: Dinner & entertainment onboard your cruise.



Tuesday Oct 19th, 2021:

Optional Balloon Ride: Early in the morning transfer to the west bank and get on your balloon, fly over the west bank over the antient monuments and the farmers land.

Valley of the Kings: Cross to the west bank of Luxor & start the visit to the hidden behind the mountains on the west bank of the Nile. Visit **the tomb of King Ramses 6 & the famous tomb of King Tutankhamen**, where they discovered over five thousand objects of jewelry, alabaster and funeral furniture. Then have the off-beaten track experience by visiting **Dra Abu el Naga where** you will be dazzled by the details in the tombs of **Roy and Shoury**.

Hatshepsut temple: Visit the temple of Hatshepsut the only female pharaoh who dressed and ruled like a king. Have a photo stop by the huge **Colossi of Memnon**.

Valley of the Queens: Visit the valley of the valley of the queens and you will have a chance to visit the most beautiful Tomb of **Queen Nefertari**.

Philae Temple: In the morning, visit the island of **Philae** and the temple of Isis, the goddess of love and passion in ancient Egypt.

The Unfinished Obelisk: See the granite quarries, where ancient Egyptians mined granite to build their eternal structures.

Felucca Ride: After lunch, go on a **leisurely felucca sailboat ride** down the Nile and sail around Elephantine Island.

Abu Simbel Temple: Drive for about 3:30 to Abu Simbel and start visiting: **Abu Simbel Temple** on the southern border of Egypt. This site is the home of two massive rock temples dedicated to Pharaoh Ramses the Second and his wife Nefertari. See the gigantic statues of the pharaoh standing for over 3200 years, flanking the entrance to one of the most impressive temples in Egypt.

Lunch: Lunch at local Nubian house.



Transfer: Transfer back your Nubian Lodge **the Anakato Nubian House**.

Saturday Oct 23rd, 2021:

Breakfast: Leisurely breakfast at your hotel.

Full day Aswan highlights: Your guide will take you for a short hike up to **the tombs of the Nobles** in Aswan. Then you will enjoy a relaxing walk in **Lord Kitchener's Island**. Then by a motor boat sail up to the Nile Cataract, explore the Nubian village of elephantine and meet with the locals.

Lunch: Lunch will be at a local Nubian restaurant.



Nubian Museum: The Nubian Museum celebrates the culture and civilization of the Nubian region of Egypt from prehistoric times to the present. It is located in the city of Aswan, on the eastern bank of the Nile, 899 kilometres south of Cairo. The museum is a three-storey building with an outdoor exhibition area. It houses the main finds of the UNESCO salvage campaign carried out at the time of the building of the High Dam, which eventually flooded that whole region. Another major exhibit is a diorama which shows the daily life of Nubian villagers. It is a community museum with an education section that organizes trips, lectures and workshops for schoolchildren, and cultural events for the public at large. In April 2000 the museum was approved by UNESCO as a centre for museology and the preservation and conservation of archaeological remains for Africa and the Middle East.





Transfer: By motorboat, sail back to your hotel.

Free evening at leisure or explore the city local souk at night.

Jerash: Jerash is a city in Jordan, north of the capital Amman. Inhabited since the Bronze Age, it's known for the ruins of the walled Greco-Roman settlement of Gerasa just outside the modern city. These include the 2nd-century Hadrian's Arch, the Corinthian columns of the Temple of Artemis and the huge Forum's oval colonnade.
